SCREAM 2012 SHIRAZ

A deep crimson wine offering dark stone fruits on the palate interlaced with aromas of cinnamon and oak. The intense plums and spices are supported in a well-structured web of fine tannins providing a pleasant velvety mouth-feel. The wine is a pleasure to drink now but will continue to reward over the next 3-6 years.

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SCREAM 2008 SHIRAZ

Very deep red to almost black in black fruit, plum and black currant aromas entwined with toasty "graphite-like" oak. Intense, mouth-filling plums and spice flavours with well-structured firm, yet fine tannins providing a velvety mouth-feel. Drink over the next five to seven years.

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SCREAM 2007 SHIRAZ

Deep magenta/crimson in colour. Intense aromas
from the darker fruits spectrum of prunes, plums
and blackcurrants sitting alongside licorice, tar,
fennel and pepper. Mouth-filling juicy purple fruits
explode in the mouth, but well balanced acidity keeps
this wine tight. Ripe, firm tannins and sustained fruits
throughout with a spicy/savoury twist.

Drink over the next 5 years.
