

SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED NEW ZEALAND WINE



This 2017 Pinot Noir has aromas of fresh berry, spice, dark bramble fruit, balanced by gentle acidity and elegant tannins. Food match with red meat dishes, pasta and turkey. The wine can be enjoyed immediately or will age well over the next three to four years.

VITICULTURE:

The 2017 Pinot Noir was produced from selected parcels of grapes grown in the region of Gladstone, a sub region of Martinborough.

WINEMAKING:

The fruit was harvested mid April, 2017.
